Please complete this form and upload as a PDF document to your International Master in Central and East European, Russian, and Eurasian Studies (IMCEERES) application (standard University of Glasgow Application for Graduate Studies) under the “Scholarship Form” document section, along with all other supporting documentation. **Note that this is not a scholarship application, as Erasmus Mundus scholarships are not available for this intake. This application form must, however, be submitted via the ‘scholarship form’ section due to a technical issue.**

You can access an editable version of this form by going to File and then Download – please ensure you download this in .docx format. Complete this form carefully, and then sign and date it, save the form as a PDF file, and upload it to your IMCEERES application along with all other supporting documentation required. Please refer to our [required documents information online](#) to ensure you submit all required documentation:

- This form, with all fields completed and with your preferred study track clearly marked
- CV (any format is acceptable, Europass is preferred)
- Two supporting references on headed paper
 - Must be dated within 24 months from the date of submission of the application
 - Must be on institutional headed paper or with an official stamp. A reference can be submitted directly to erasmusreferences@glasgow.ac.uk from the referee’s institutional address. References will not be accepted from a personal email address
 - Must be signed with an electronic or wet-ink signature. A typed name is not sufficient
 - At least one of the two references should be an academic reference. One may be a professional reference where it is not possible to obtain two academic references
- Transcripts of all university-level academic studies to date (undergraduate and any postgraduate studies) in both original language and, if applicable, in an official English translation. Studies earlier than university are not required
- Degree Certificates of all university-level academic studies to date (undergraduate and any postgraduate studies) in both original language and, if applicable, in an official English translation
- Proof of English-language proficiency (see [IMCEERES English Language Requirements online information](#))
- Colour scan of current passport photo page (candidates with multiple nationalities must decide at the application stage under which one nationality to apply)

Please note that all above documents are required in order to receive an unconditional offer of study.

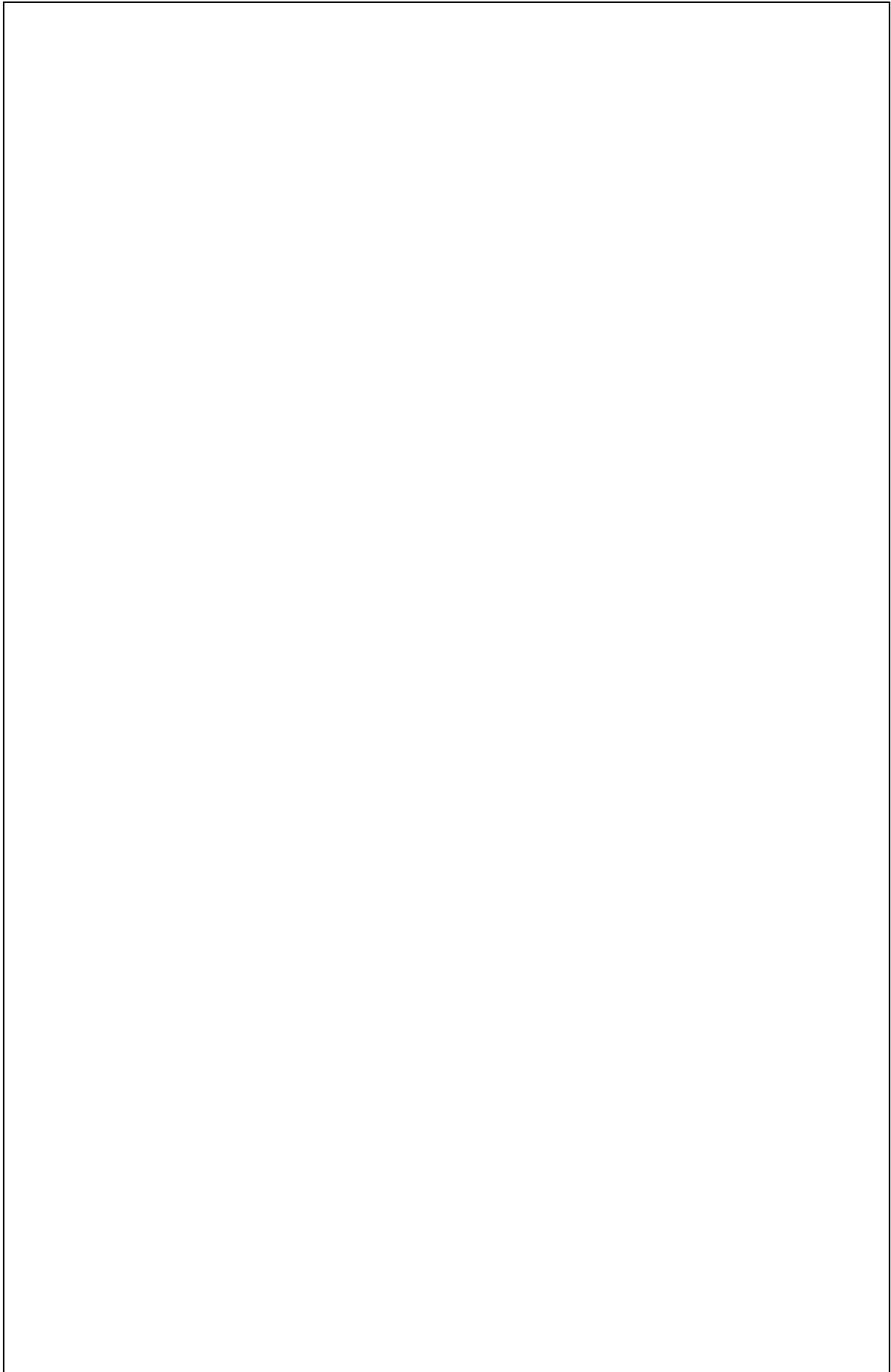

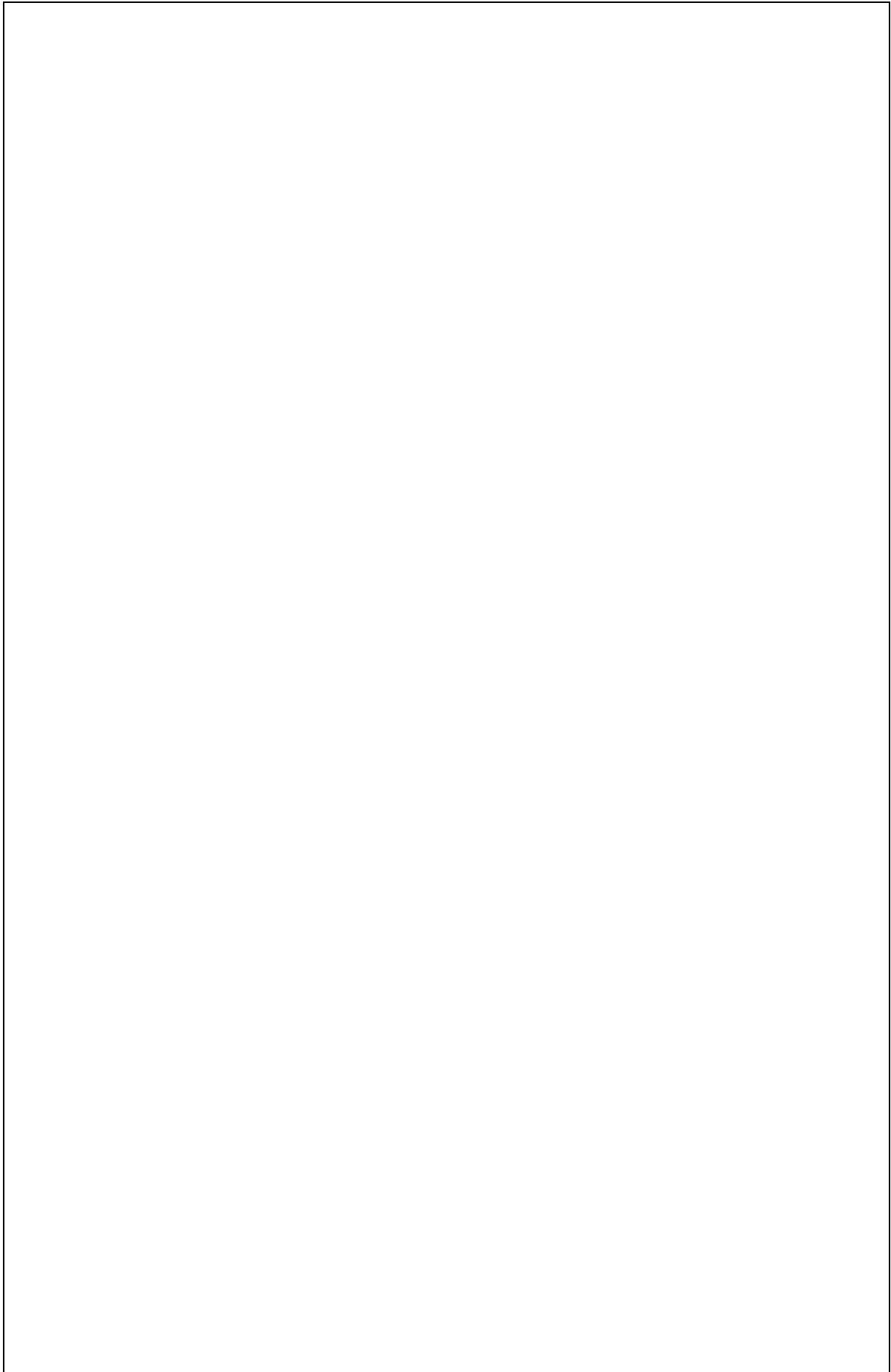
2. Personal Statement

IMPORTANT: Samples of academic work will not be taken into consideration and should not be submitted.

Please be as precise as you can when writing your Supporting Personal Statement. Do not repeat yourself and do not exceed the word limit (1,200 words). You should make sure that you address the following issues in your personal statement:

- You should outline your motivation for choosing the IMCEERES programme (i.e. how it complements and develops your previous studies; how it relates to your potential future career path; how it relates to your personal and academic interests)
- Explain why you think that you are a good candidate for the programme given your previous studies, and how they relate to the courses offered on the programme in both years. In doing so, you should explain how it relates to your proposed regional study track and to your choice of second year country of study and language
- Indicate one or two elective courses from the programme structure that you think might be helpful in preparing for your research.
- You should highlight your participation in conferences, internships, non-governmental organisations, summer schools, and other socially sensitive or political activity, as well as any prizes/awards received, even if these activities are not specifically connected to the area of Russian, Central, and East European studies





3. Language

Please rank your language training preferences in order, where 1st choice refers to the most required language for your research/study needs. You should also state the anticipated level of language training required for each of the languages. Students with advanced knowledge of a particular language from the region will be required to learn another Central and East European language.
